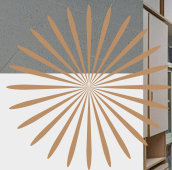

About Us

Caritas Pui Tak Centre was formerly known as Morning Star Hostel. It was established by The Sisters of the Good Shepherd in 1972. It began to receive subsidies from the Social Welfare Department in 1980 and was taken over by Caritas - Hong Kong in October 1991. In October 2003, it was officially renamed as Caritas Pui Tak Centre.



SWD has provided additional funding to this service since February 2014 to provide professional support services to girls and their parents/carers with cognitive, emotional and behavioural needs and problems.

Objective

Residential services are provided so that girls can learn practical life skills and develop a positive working attitude and self-reliance.

Mode of Service

Caritas Pui Tak centre provides a home-like residential care and individual counseling service, allowing residents to receive care, nurturing, development opportunities and individual supervision services in a warm and friendly atmosphere.

Service Target

Girls aged between 16 and under 21 who are students and/or working youth with relationship problems with their families or do not have a family to return to. (The serving capacity is 28.)



Content of the Services

We provide residential services including individual care and counselling as well as recreational and educational programs.

Service Area

- 01** Provide a stable, orderly, privacy-respecting, and warm home living environment.
- 02** Provide independent living skills and self-care training.
- 03** Provide comprehensive in-residence training and activity so as to develop interpersonal relationship and social skill.
- 04** Conduct case conferences(CRM) to assess adaptation and develop individual welfare plan.
- 05** Arrange clinical psychological services for girls with mild emotional problems and special needs.
- 06** Provide various developmental and recreational group and activities to fulfill personal developmental needs.



Meal Fee

Residential service is free, and meal charges are HK\$700 per month. Breakfast is provided daily, and dinner is available from Monday to Friday (excluding public holidays). Meal charges will be adjusted annually if necessary.

Application and Withdrawal of Residential Service

Application should be made by referring registered social worker through Central Referral System of the Social Welfare Department's Child Residential Care Service(CRSRC). If applicants need to withdraw from the service during the application process or after moving in, they can make a request to the hostel social worker and referral social worker.

Application and Withdrawal of Agency-based Enhancement of Professional Staff Support Services

Girls can apply this service or evaluated by the hostel social worker for applying this service to receive psychological evaluation, counseling or treatment from clinical psychologist. If Girls wish to withdraw from this service, they must submit a written application to the responsible hostel social worker. Girls under the age of 18 must obtain written consent from parents/caregivers/ referring social workers to apply for and withdraw from this service.
